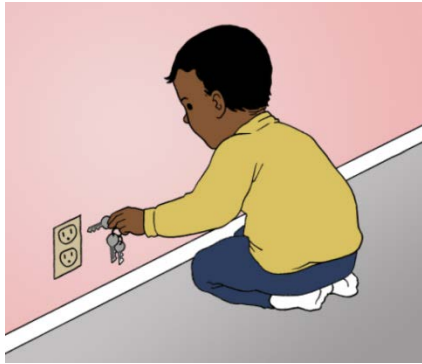


REPORTING SMART METER/METER-BASE ASSEMBLY FIRES

What Is It?

Is a receptacle with a safety function that prevents unwanted insertion of foreign objects into the device.

Why would I want to install them?



Each year, more than 110 kids under 15 years old end up with serious injuries in the hospital in Ontario from electrical shock. Many of the injuries happened when they stick objects into an unprotected plug. Installing Tamper Resistant (TR) receptacle adds another level of safety for your children.

Installation of the TR receptacles is also required by law when you are replacing your old receptacles with a new one.

How does a Tamper Resistant Receptacle work?



TR Plug prevents little ones from inserting an object into outlets. The device has a shutter inside that only allows electrical plugs to be inserted into the receptacles.

How do I identify TR receptacles from others?



Tamper-resistant receptacles are marked with "TR"
